MEETING BUSINESS

REVIEW OF GOALS FOR 2016-2017:

- ✓ The current year's goals were discussed. Tim Sweeney informed the Board that he felt confident that the district had effectively met 15.5 of the 17 goals the Board had outlined for the district.

- ✓ **Priorities:**
 - Safety
 - Continue to work towards more secure and safe campuses
 - Food Service runs in the black

BOARD GOALS 2017-2018:

- ✓ **Priorities:**
 - Continue to enhance CTE programs and create two additional Career Pathways – one is the early education pathway, plus one additional pathway
 - Create adverse weather routes
 - Create relationships with community colleges beyond the current relationship with SWOCC
- ✓ **Secondary:**
 - K-2 updated math curriculum
 - Student tutoring/student mentoring credit

- Liaison for non-district sports/after school activity coordinator
- Innovative curriculum for changing times
- Maintain or increase current staffing levels

- ✓ **CIP:**
 - District provides schools with tech resources, tech assistance and PD.
 - All students in the district have access to and develop proficiency in utilizing technology to enhance their presentation for college and career.
 - All educators differentiate instruction, adapt content and utilize digital tools and resources to create personalized opportunities.
 - All educators have high expectations for each learner and develop challenging learning experiences that held all learners to meet high standards.

- ✓ **Future:**
 - Prepare the district for the end of the current bond and progress towards rolling out a new bond. Not a one-year goal but a multi-year objective
