## **Public Conduct on School Property**

- 1. The Board has the responsibility to enact necessary rules and regulations to preserve order, protect property and to prevent injury or threatened injury to anyone on school district property.
- 2. No person, whether a student, nonstudent, any member of the community or any visitor shall conduct himself/herself in such a manner as to impede, delay or otherwise interfere with the orderly conduct of the educational program of the school district or any other activity taking place on school property which has been authorized by the Board, the superintendent, the building principal or other authorized district administrator.
- 3. The Board exercises complete control and supervision of all school district property at all times.
- 4. School grounds and buildings are owned by the district and as such are open to members of the public who are there on legitimate business.
- 5. The building principal, the principal's designee or Coos County law enforcement officials shall issue or mail a written warning to any individual who is on the premises for no legitimate business, and shall direct the person to leave the premises. If the individual continues to trespass, the building principal or the principal's designee shall sign a complaint with the appropriate court.
- 6. It is the Board's intent that weapons and vehicle traffic laws of the state of Oregon shall be applicable on district property. Any administrator or designee personally observing violations, shall contact the Coquille Police Department to sign the appropriate complaint. Coos County law enforcement officials are authorized to enforce weapons and traffic laws on school grounds.
