Homework:

Yellow homework packets are due and new homework packets will be sent home on the last day of each week. Limit the time spent on homework each night to 15 minutes. Think Central and Moby Max:

All weekly reading and math assessments will be completed on Think Central. Please monitor your child's progress on the website throughout the year. Math and reading textbooks are also available on Think Central. Moby Max is a great tool to help sharpen your child's math and reading skills!

Spelling Tests:

Be on the lookout for new weekly spelling lists in the Weekly Homework Packet that goes home on the last day of each week. I encourage students to take some time over the weekend to become familiar with the new words before the start of the upcoming week. If the spelling list is misplaced the words are inside the weekly reading packet and extra copies are available in the classroom.

Spelling tests are on the last day of every week.

20/20 words (all basic words correct) = "Super Speller"

25/20 words (all basic and all challenge words correct) = "Super Duper Speller"
