#### **IMPORTANT TUITION INFORMATION**

The Driver Education program is a self-supporting program. The cost of the program is shared by student tuition and state reimbursement. To be eligible for state reimbursement, thus receiving the listed tuition price, the student must be 15-17 years of age and have a valid Oregon permit.

*If a student is 18 years older, and or turns 18 prior to completing the program, or obtains their license prior to completing the program, they are NOT eligible for state reimbursement and must pay the full amount of \$460.*
