- Addition and subtraction to 10
- Number order to 20 (dot to dot)
- Number recognition and identification

- Blending sounds/letters for example /c/ /a/ /t/ cat, rhyming, alphabet recognition (dot to dot)
- Writing simple sentences using HFW. Sentences should be connected to the topic.
