SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Sweeney provided the Board with an update regarding COVID-19 state requirements, including Gov. Brown's Executive Order establishing steps required to receive allocations from the State School Fund during the closure.

Additionally, he provided information on Coquille School District's response to the state mandate. Superintendent Sweeney informed the Board of the steps being taken to ensure the district's compliance with providing supplemental education, continuing to provide school meals, offering child care, developing a plan of operation of essential, non-educational services, and continuing to regularly pay school district employees.

CSD Board members then posed a variety of questions of Mr. Sweeney, which he addressed to the best extent possible given the quickly changing recommendations and state requirements.
