### April is Child Abuse Prevention Month

Each April, in honor of Child Abuse Prevention Month, it is time to take pause and reflect on how we as a community can continue to combine our strengths in learning more about and preventing child abuse and neglect.

According to the Department of Health & Human Services annual report in 2019, CPS agencies received a national estimate of 4.4 million total referrals (acf.hhs.gov, 2019). That is an increase of around 500,000 since 2015.




# Students' Corner: A Place for Student-Submitted
