- Thank the School Board for the Music Program. Ms. Rostykus is our new music teacher. She has been amazing. For this presentation I brough some students with me tonight, Lyric Cagley, Lillian Wirebaugh, Kira Helms, and Hailey. Students stated that they love choir, and all want to grow up to become singers.
- Music Program
 - Every Student in the Building attends Music Class
 - 5th & 6th Graders have the option of taking a daily Choir Class
 - Currently 25 6th Graders in Band
 - Learning how to read music.

SCHOOL BOARD GOAL REPORT

Student Engagement in the use of Technology Mid/End of year – Tanya Sinko, Sean Wirebaugh, and Paige Yi.

- Sean – New Firewall replacement finished. 75% of our network switches are 20 years old. 10 years is normally when you look to replace. Looking at E-rate funding to make purchases.
- Tanya – Our IT Department is a huge part of the reason why our students can use the digital formats of the curriculum. WLE uses Odysseyware along with Enhanced with Learning A-Z, ISL for Math & English, and Generation Genius for Science. Smart Boards have been brought back into the classrooms at Lincoln. Using Education.com Music, Online Exercises, and being able to print materials also. CVE teachers are using Freckle Premium as a bridge until next year with the new curriculum being adopted. 4th Graders have started using GoogleSuites for writing. Just adopted AMIRA title I intervention/dyslexia screener.
- Paige - At the Jr & High school the students are accessing chrome books and the internet every day. The students are mirroring just how you use technology at work. They are accessing spreadsheets, google docs, and videos. This fall we adopted the new ELA which has the capability to send out “Blasts” to the students (Like a Bell Ringer) teachers pushes out prompts and students can response. That is preparing the students for higher education. Our Smart Boards are moving over to the Newline Interactive Displays. The Robotics team and Mr. Ward have been working hard the Robotics program and competing. They’re working really had to coding and building robots. The students have been learning coding and some have advanced to java script. WLH Odysseyware, Google Classrooms, Google Meets, Simulators: CAT Excavator, CAT Bulldozer, CAT Graders, CAT Front-end, Loaders, Virage Truck/Bus, and Redbird MX2 Flight Simulators. We have partnered with SWOCC with VR, Victory XR: VR Educational Program. WLHS also has 6 Drones.

CONSENT AGENDA


Steve Britton made a motion to approve 9.1 to 9.5. Cliff Wheeler seconded the motion; it passed unanimously.
