

Research

District staff are encouraged to participate in research for the development and improvement of education. Staff who propose to engage in research, e.g., study toward advanced work or for use in classroom instruction, using district resources or students submit a proposal to the principal for approval prior to commencing such research. If approved, and the study results in material or practices which may be useful to other district staff, such will be reviewed by and may be made available for distribution throughout the district as determined by administration. For the protection of all concerned, privacy rights of students or other individuals involved in such research must be protected.

Research which is conducted by or for a nondistrict individual or organization must be approved by the superintendent[or designee].
